The Storm Drain Art Project is a program that uses art as a tool to communicate stormwater pollution prevention messaging. **Storm drain murals are original designs created by artists and are the artist's interpretation of stormwater pollution prevention.**

Most storm drains in the city direct stormwater from our streets to our streams and, eventually, Lake Superior. The storm drain art messaging helps to keep things like garbage and pet waste from entering storm drains.
